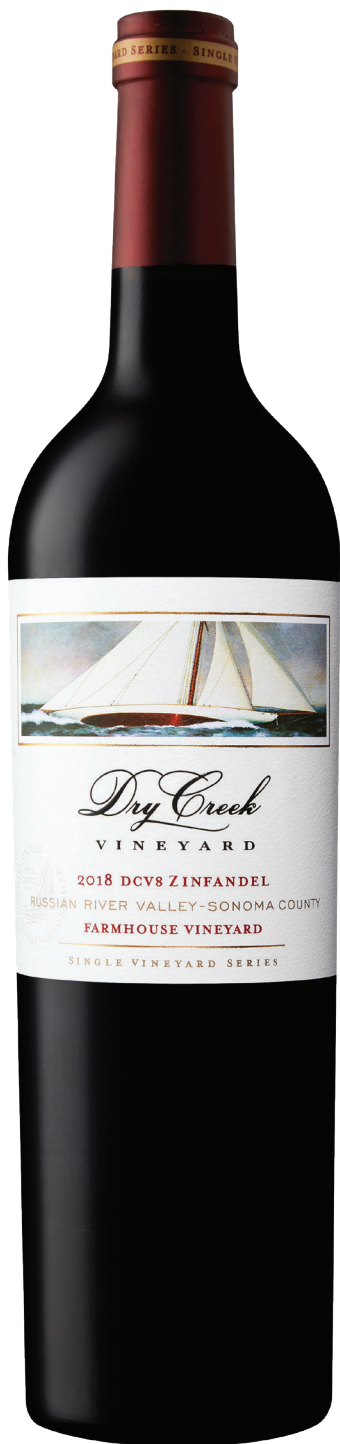




DCV8 ESTATE ZINFANDEL — FARMHOUSE VINEYARD *Dry Creek Valley*
