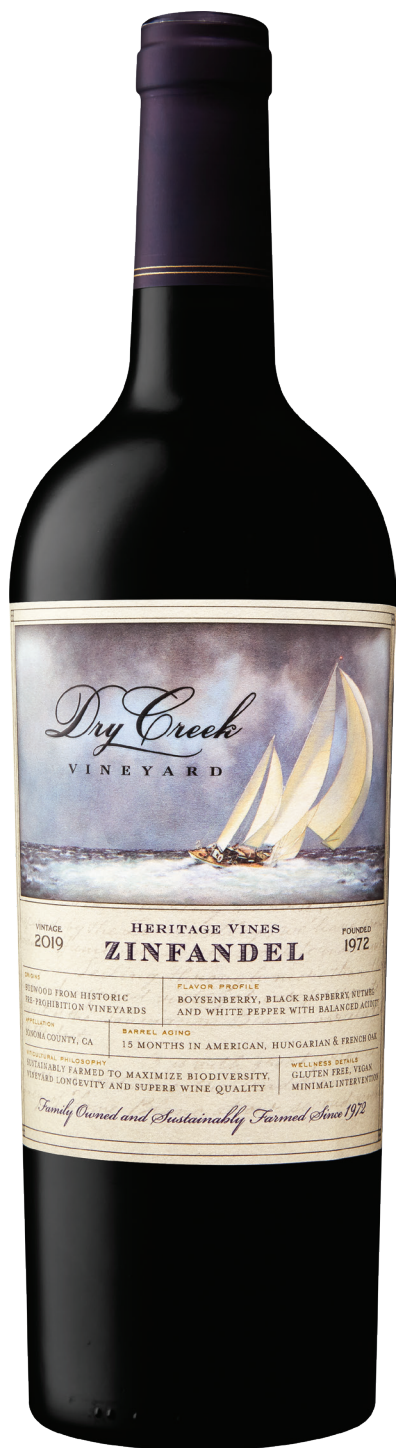




HERITAGE VINES ZINFANDEL Sonoma County

92 Points - The 2019 Zinfandel Heritage Vines showed beautifully, with a pure, up-front, silky and textured style as well as classic plum and berry fruits, notes of incense, pepper, and orange blossom, supple tannins, and a great finish. Drink this charming, pleasure-bent beauty over the coming 5-7 years.

91 Points - A briary old-school Zin, with lively blackberry, licorice and toasty underbrush flavors that zip along toward the snappy finish. Drink now through 2029. 23,000 cases made. -Tim Fish

91 Points - A spirited red, with a supple texture and well-layered black cherry, licorice and grilled sage flavors that pick up speed toward fine-grained tannins. -Tim Fish

90 Points - Blended with 22% Petite Sirah and 1% Carignan, this thick, full-bodied wine is robust in feel. Cranberry, plum and blackberry give the fruit a tangy brightness before finishing touches of cola and cinnamon. -Virginie Boone
