2019 VINTAGE

91 Points - The 2019 Pinot Noir DCV10 comes from an estate vineyard in the Russian River Valley (the DV10 Vineyard) and has a great nose of ripe cherries and strawberries as well as peppery herbs, underbrush, and subtle marine-like, salty, iron nuances. Nicely textured and medium-bodied, it's well worth drinking over the coming 5-7 years.

90 Points - A small-production offering, this wine is silky and red-fruited, with stemmy, earthy characteristics of forest floor and black tea. A dense, velvety midpalate finds highlights of baking spice and oak, providing a lasting richness that is balanced in acidity. -Virginie Boone

2016 VINTAGE

91 Points - Plenty of spice and fine, sweet, rose perfume on the nose of this pinot, leading to a very bright, smooth and easygoing palate with subtle oak spice warming the soft, approachable finish.
