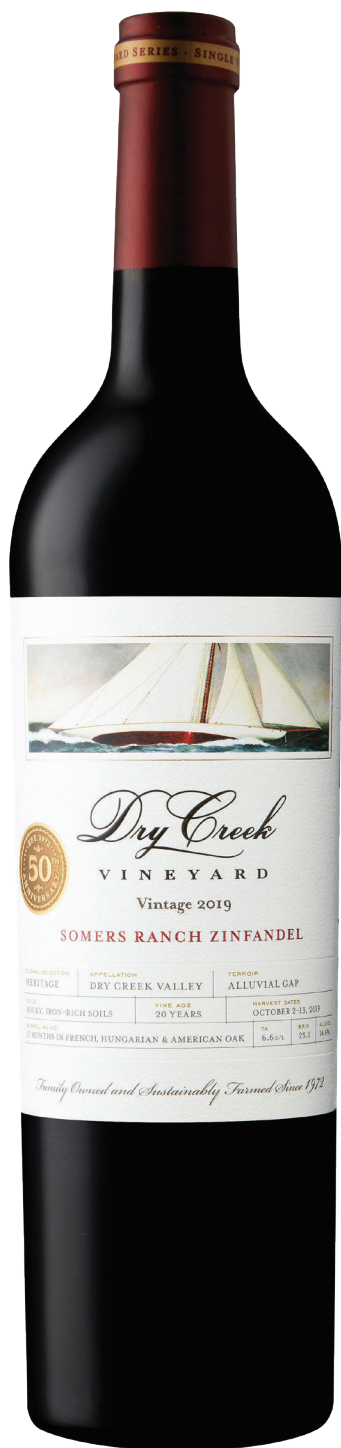

Complex layers of cigar box and berry pie highlight a full-bodied and generous palate. Well-integrated tannins and baking spice sit alongside the fleshy texture. -Virginie Boone
