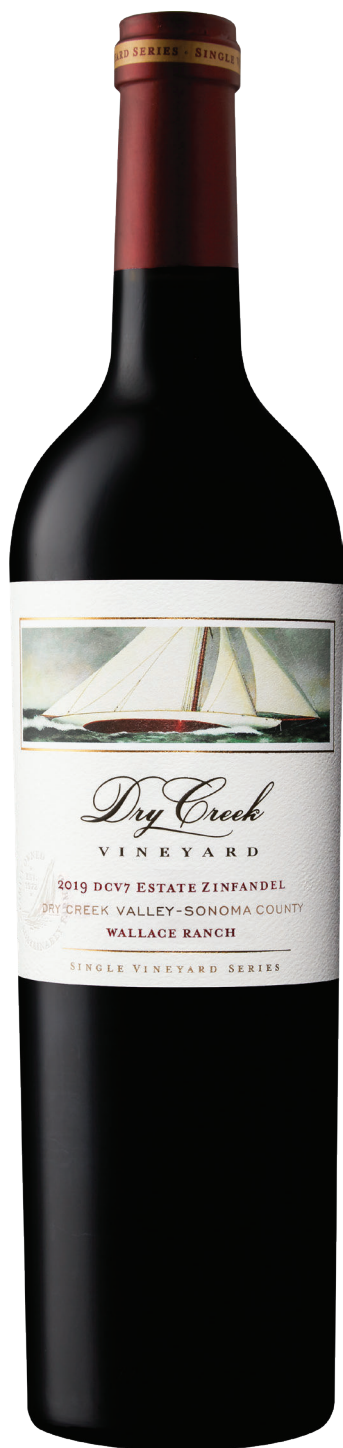




DCV7 ESTATE ZINFANDEL — WALLACE RANCH *Dry Creek Valley*



2019 VINTAGE

WINE SPECTATOR
APRIL 2022

93 Points - Old-school meets modern polish with this lively Zinfandel, which unveils layered cherry and cranberry flavors that take on notes of dusky spice and bay leaf as this drives toward snappy tannins. Drink now through 2030. -Tim Fish

2018 VINTAGE

WINE SPECTATOR
MAY 2021

92 Points - Perky and vibrant, with layered briar patch, wild berry and toasty sage flavors that take on richness toward medium-grained tannins. Drink now through 2028. 569 cases made. -Tim Fish

WINE & SPIRITS
MAY 2021

91 Points - The Wallace family planted this vineyard in 1994 using a selection from a pre-Prohibition vineyard, grafting those cuttings onto phylloxera-resistant rootstock. The vines grow in sandy loam soils adjacent to their winery in Healdsburg. Those heritage selections gave a wine that smells like wild anise, the red-cherry flavors simple and lush while the tannins have the spark of rock hitting rock. A warm, satin-textured pleasure for spicy pork tamales. -Joshua Greene

2017 VINTAGE

91 Points - Briary yet precise, with multilayered wild berry, smoky anise and pepper flavors that build structure toward refined tannins. Drink now through 2028. 525 cases made. -Tim Fish
